One activity that is being planned is the exhibition of engineering related displays to enlighten the public to the various disciplines and functions of engineering.

We encourage your organization to participate in the Engineers Week exhibition by providing a display at the Colonial Park Mall during Engineers Week. Your display can be done in any well-organized form that demonstrates the engineering profession and attempts to increase public awareness of engineers and encourages young people to consider engineering related career.

To reserve space for your display and/or demonstration, please complete the enclosed form and return it to me by January 25, 2009. The display space and available electrical outlets are limited and will be allocated on a first come, first served basis. Free standing displays are preferred, however, a limited number of tables can be provided by the mall. We are not allowed to use tables that are not provided by the mall. Standard spaces are approximately 10' long by 5' deep. If you need more space than that, please ask for two spaces. Please note that your organization is responsible for turning display power or lighting on and off each day. An automatic timer is suggested. Set up of displays will occur on Sunday morning (2/15) between 9 am and 11 am. Tear down is scheduled for Saturday evening (2/21) between 9 pm and 11 pm. I will provide you with complete details including a location map, approximately two weeks prior to Engineers Week.
